Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Tuesday 26th April 2016 at 7.30pm Bempton Primary School, School Lane, Bempton.

PLANNING APPLICATION

16/00941/PLF – Erection of extension to side of existing storage shed to form play barn and cafe. Marton Manor, Flamborough Road, Sewerby. YO15 1DU.

Applicant: Mr & Mrs S Waind. Application type: Full Planning Permission.

Bempton Parish Council object to the above planning application for the following reasons:-

Firstly the car parking facilities are not clearly indicated or the revised parking capacity stated, as such the parish feel there is inadequate parking provision given to the proposed play barn.

Secondly the council do not believe that the conflict between the agricultural vehicle access and the visitors car parking has been addressed clearly, more information needs to be given to the serious issue of traffic movement within the complex.

CLERKS REPORT

I sent a reply to David Siddle requesting for the data used to identify that Bempton was in need of affordable housing. A reply was received and discuss, it was agreed for Mr Siddle to be invited to a future meeting.

The potholes on Bempton Lane, Butterwick Farm and outside Munton's were reported.

The faded road narrowing sign on High Street has been reported.

I have received a reply from Flamborough Parish Council regarding the flooding along Flamborough Road, they have indicated that the ditches in question belong to Grange Farm.

The VAT forms have been posted for a refund.

I have booked to attend the planning liaison meeting on the 09th June, I am also attending a presentation in Malton on the 11th May from INEOS Shale.

The drain outside the post office was reported blocked and has since been cleared.

A form was received to allow the use of the school for the parish meetings, this has been completed and returned to ERYC.

I am chasing a reply from the PCC regarding the Emergency Plan.

HIGHWAYS

Potholes on Cliff Lane to be reported.

Cllr Burton recommended that the council write to the Director of Street Scene regarding the need for transport infrastructure within our area due to the increase in tourism. All councillors were in favour.

STREET LIGHTING

No faults were reported.
