MINUTES

The RSPB have once again removed the Right of Way sign, the access around the building to the cliffs is no longer clear.

POLICE UPDATE

There has been two reports of anti-social behaviour, one was at the village hall with a couple of children climbing over the fencing and an aggressive parent outside the school regarding parking. I will be speaking with the traffic wardens to attend the school more frequently.

CLERKS REPORT

The grass cutting contract has been signed and returned. The first cut was carried out last week.

A letter was sent to the village hall enquiring about the historic reserve.

The Use of school form has been completed and returned back to ERYC.

The blocked drain on High Street has been reported, the fish heads on Cliff Lane and the damaged grit bin on Main Street were also reported.
