19/02853/PLF – Erection of a detached bungalow **118/19**

Land South East of 1 Gillus Lane Bempton East Yorkshire

Applicant: Mr & Mrs P Oldroyd. Application type: Full Planning Permission

The proposed location of the dwelling would be constructed upon elevated land compared to the surrounding properties and could have a detrimental impact on both their amenities and privacy.
